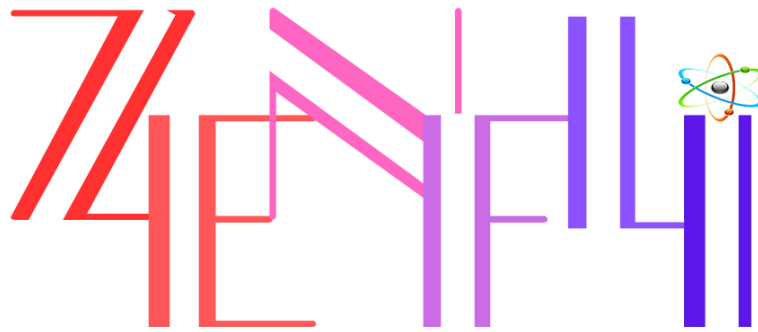
NURSING BODY LANGUAGE

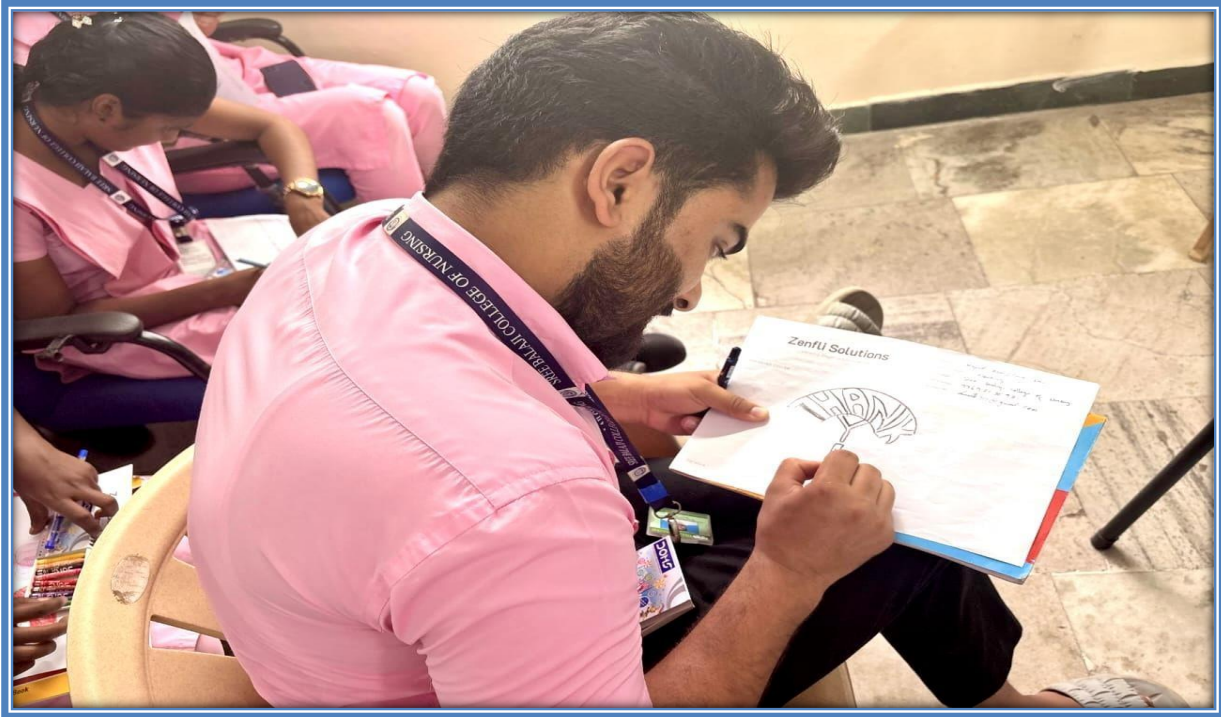

Mothers were taught about goals, symptoms to be noted, do’s and don’t ,complications during antenatal period.



POSTNATAL CARE

It is a pleasure to be here today to speak about a topic that is incredibly important but often overlooked-postnatal care refers to both mother and newborn receive in the first six weeks after birth-a critical period for both physical and emotional adjustment.



BREAST FEEDING TECHNIQUES

It was started with theoretical session followed by practical session. Demonstration was done for all the mothers. Mothers were learned how to hold and feed the baby adequately.



ANEMIA IN PREGNANCY

Pregnant women need more iron and folic acid than usual to support the growing fetus and the increased blood volume in their body. If this increased need isn't met through diet. Encourage the mothers to seek proper care, eat well, and take supplements as needed.



FOOD SOURCES INCREASE THE BREAST MILK

It an important topic for new mothers-how the food choices can help increase breast milk production. Breast feeding is not only a beautiful bonding experience between mother and child, but it's also essential for baby's growth and immune health. There



are natural foods known to support and increase milk supply.

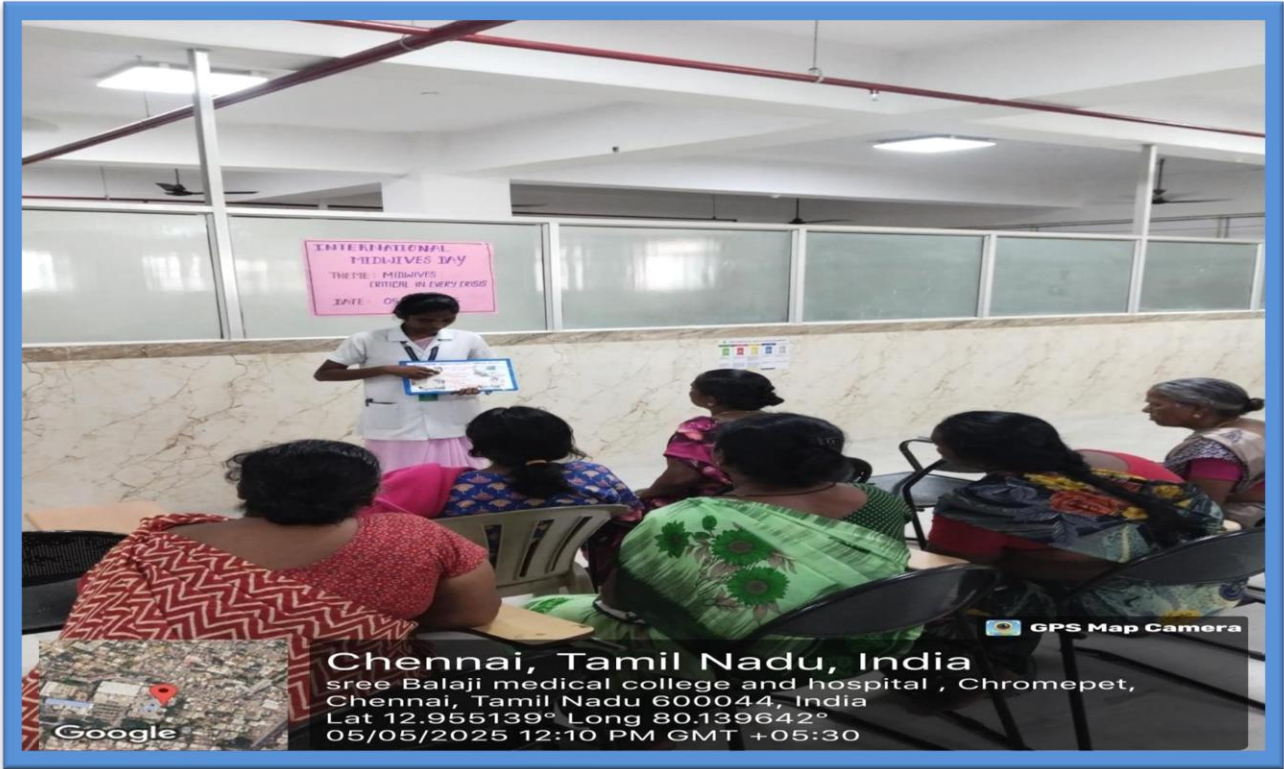
INTERNATIONAL MIDWIVES' DAY 2025

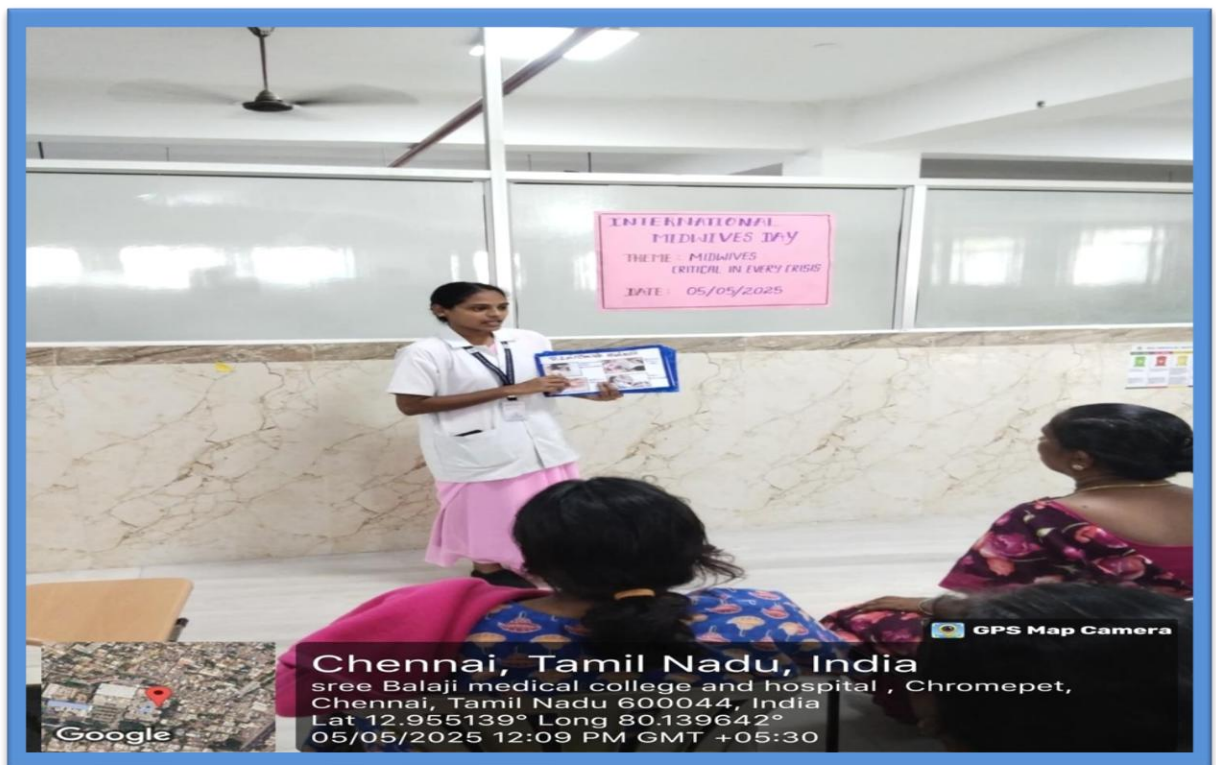

Students participated in giving health talk to the care givers and mothers in the ward. They were able to clear the doubts asked by the mothers.

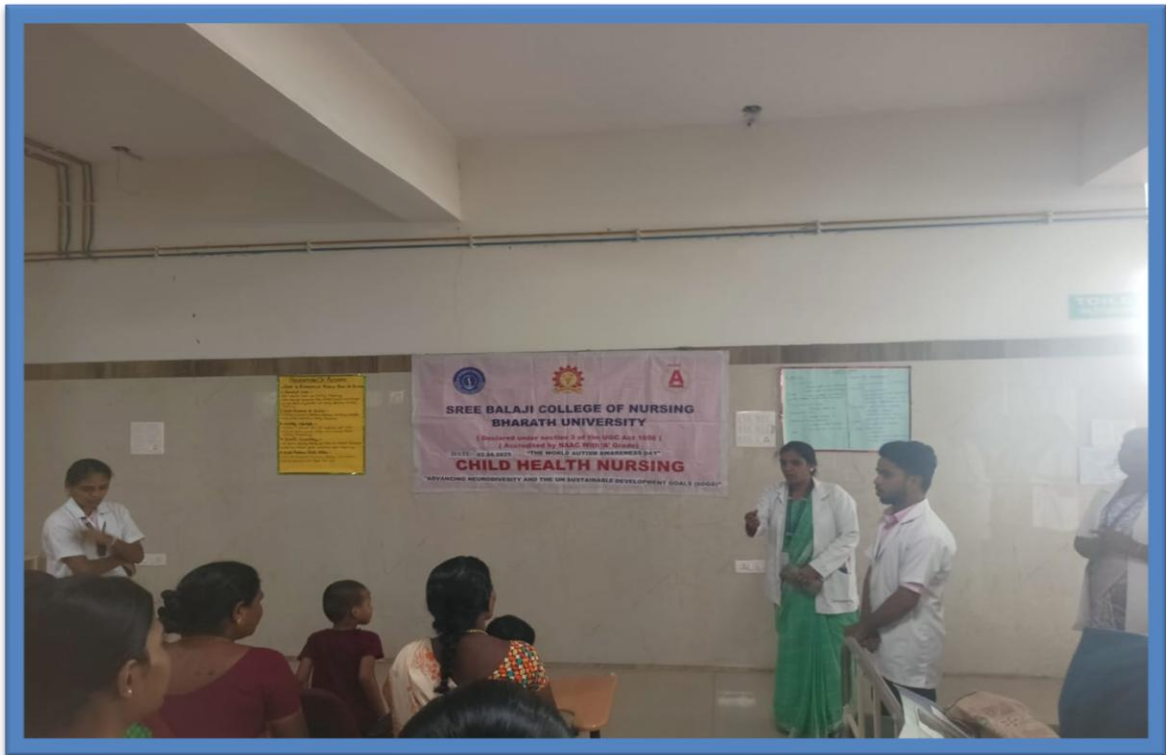
WORLD THALASSEMIA DAY- 8 MAY 2025

INDIA COUNCIL FOR MEDICAL RESEARCH IN TUBECULOSIS



DATE OF VISIT: [18.6.25]

VENUE: INDIA COUNCIL FOR MEDICAL RESEARCH IN TUBERCULOSIS

INTRODUCTION:

As part of the academic curriculum, the M.sc nursing I year students of Sree Balaji College of Nursing visited the Indian Council of Medical

Research (ICMR), Chennai. The aim of the visit was to gain practical



knowledge about the public health research activities, infrastructure, and national health programmes including Tuberculosis and DOTS (Directly Observed Treatment, Short-course) therapy.

LOCATION:

The Indian Council of Medical Research (ICMR) is located at: Indian Council of Medical Research

National Institute for Research in Tuberculosis (NIRT)

No.1, Mayor Sathyamoorthy Road, Chetpet, Chennai - 600031 Tamil Nadu, India

The institution is easily accessible by road and well connected to public transport.

PLACE OVERVIEW:

ICMR, through its division NIRT, is a premier research institute working under the Ministry of Health and Family Welfare, Government of India. It plays a crucial role in medical research with a specific focus on infectious diseases like tuberculosis. The institution is dedicated to both laboratory and field research in areas such as epidemiology, immunology, and public health.



INFRASTRUCTURE:

The ICMR campus at Chennai is well-equipped with modern infrastructure, including:

- ★ Administrative blocks and research laboratories
- ★ Microbiology and diagnostic labs
- ★ Lecture halls and conference rooms
- ★ Digital libraries and resource centres
- ★ Waiting and reception areas for patients

The environment is clean, organized, and promotes a research-oriented atmosphere.



FACILITIES:

Students were introduced to various facilities such as:

- Laboratory services for diagnostic investigations
- Research laboratories for TB bacteriology, molecular biology, and clinical trials
- TB outpatient department offering DOTS therapy



Training and education units for public health awareness-Demonstration units for patient care and follow up.

EDUCATIONAL SESSION:

A special class on Tuberculosis and DOTS therapy was conducted by Ms. Shakila, an experienced health educator from ICMR. Key points discussed during the session included:

- + Overview of tuberculosis – causes, symptoms, diagnosis
- + National TB Elimination Program (NTEP)
- + Implementation of DOTS therapy in India
- + Role of nurses and healthcare professionals in TB control
- + Patient counselling, adherence strategies, and contact tracing.



The session was highly informative and interactive, enhancing the students' understanding of tuberculosis control strategies in real-world setting
