It is attached to Sree Balaji Medical College and Hospital. This Hospital has various Multi Specialities with a bed strength of 1500. Our college is accredited with CGPA of 3.20 on four point scale at A Grade.

OBJECTIVES

On the completion of the Basic B.Sc (N) programme the students will

- i) Acquire knowledge of theory and principles of nursing and allied subjects which are involved in the delivery of comprehensive nursing practice.
- ii) Apply scientific principles and knowledge in providing comprehensive nursing care.
- iii) Provide nursing care based on steps of nursing process in collaboration with other health care members.
- iv) Demonstrate critical thinking skill in making decisions in all situations in order to provide quality care.
- v) Utilize latest trend and technology in providing health care.
- vi) Provide promotive, preventive and restorative health services to individual and groups.
- vii) Demonstrate leadership qualities, problem solving and decision making abilities in various situations.
- viii) Communicate, effectively with individuals, groups and members of the health care team in order to promote collaborative and comprehensive health care.
- ix) Practice ethical values in their personal and professional life and rendering nursing care in a spirit of service to the welfare of the society.

ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS

Application form

Application form and prospectus can be obtained from the Administrative Office, Sree Balaji College of Nursing, Chennai -600 044.

ELIGIBILITY

- i) Male & female candidates are eligible.
- ii) Age limit for admission:
A candidate should have completed the age of 17years at the time of admission / as on 31st December of the year.
- iii) Candidates should have passed +2 in Science subject. They should have passed their higher secondary examination conducted by the government of Tamil Nadu or an equivalent examination accepted by the governing council by Bharath University. In the qualified examination they must have taken the following subjects Physics, Chemistry, Biology and English and obtained a maximum of 45% marks in each subjects.

SUBMISSION OF APPLICATION

- 1) The sanctioned annual intake of the College is 100 which will be filled by the management through Entrance examination conducted by the selection committee.
- 2) The intending candidates must submit their applications to the Administrative office, Sree Balaji College of Nursing, Chennai- 600 044.

CERTIFICATES AND DOCUMENTS

Xerox copies of the mark sheets and other documents should be enclosed to the application form.

- i) Transfer certificate from the higher secondary school.
- ii) Mark sheet of +2 or pre degree or equivalent.
- iii) Conduct certificate from head of the institution, wherein the applicant studied for her qualifying examination.
- iv) Community certificate.
- v) Medical fitness certificate from authorized medical practioner.
- vi) Hepatitis B & Typhoid vaccination certificates.
- vii) Application with incomplete information and not accompanied by documents required as above will be rejected.

- viii) Candidates called for interview should bring all the above certificates and mark sheets in original with them.
- ix) When a candidate desires to get admission into the Bharath University, he/she is expected along with his/her eligibility certificate.

SELECTION OF CERTIFICATE

- Candidates will be selected by the college selection committee on the basis of merit which will be held through interview of the students.

Admission granted is provisional subject to:

- i) Indian Nursing Council norms.
- ii) The payment of college & hostel fees.
- iii) Submission of Eligibility Certificate.

PROGRAMME OF STUDY

The B.Sc., (N) programme is a four year course includes 3 ½ years course and 6 months internship practice. Examination will be conducted by the Bharath University in the month of August in every year.

INSTRUCTIONS

- The minimum requirement is 100% of the attendance for the clinical experience and 80% attendance of the theory in each subject.
- Any day of absence in the clinical area without prior permission will be counted as two days of absence and will have to be made up subsequently the mark list will be withheld until all the absenteeism has been made up.

ACADEMIC PROGRESS

- i) Minimum pass marks shall be 50% in each of the theory and practical papers separately.
- ii) A candidate has to pass in theory and practical exam separately in each of the paper.

- iii) If a candidate fails in either theory or practical paper he/she has to re-appear for both the papers (theory and practical).
- iv) Maximum number of attempts permitted for each paper is 3 including first attempt.
- v) A candidate failing in more than two subjects will not be promoted to the next year.
- vi) The maximum period to complete the course successfully should not exceed 8 years.
- vii) On successful completion of the programme, they should register with the Tamil Nadu Nurses and Midwives Council.

ANNUAL EXAMINATIONS & RESULTS

As per the regulations of the Bharath university

COLLEGE FEES

Each candidate selected for admission should pay the fees during registration. Then, at the beginning of each year the student should pay all the fees for the year.

UNIFORM

- Students are required to wear the uniform prescribed by the college during clinical experience and theory block.
- Students should put up their hair and should wear prescribed foot wear.
- Students are not allowed to wear any jewellery except small ear stud/rings during the clinical experience.

VACATIONS

- Vacations are given according to the programme of study, 2 weeks in December and 4 weeks in May respectively. Students are not permitted to have any other kind of leave or absenteeism.
- A medical certificate from a registered medical practitioner must be produced within 3 days in the event of illness.

STUDENTS ACTIVITIES:

- Students are expected to participate in all the activities organized by the college. Students are encouraged to become members of the Students Nurses Association. The Student Nurses Association will provide a mean of personal and professional development for the nursing student.
- To use leisure time creatively and effectively, they are provided with facilities for indoor and outdoor games.
- Educational trips will be arranged during the course and students will have to bear the full expenses of the trip.

CONDUCT AND DISCIPLINE

- Students are responsible to the principal for the behaviour both in and outside the College.
- Students should maintain silence in class, library and in the corridors.
- Students should make every effort to take care of the College, Hostel and Hospital property.
- Any damage to the property of the College, Hostel and Hospital will be replaced by the candidate.
- Students are required to abide by the rules and regulations laid by the Hospital, Hostel and College authorities' violation of rules will entail disciplinary action.
- Mobile Phones are not allowed inside the Class rooms and Clinical areas.
- Students are required to maintain ethical and professional standards and behaviours. Raging in any form will lead to expulsion.
- Students will not involve themselves in religious activity for publicity within the campus during tenure in the college.
- Students who are found to have major problems like cardiac problems, epilepsy, psychiatric problems or any major illness will have to discontinue their course.
- Voluntary withdrawal students who have voluntary withdraw from the college shall be required to pay full fees for the entire course. The fees already paid will not be refunded.

HEALTH PROGRAMME

- Each Student will undergo an annual Medical check up. Students will be immunized against infectious disease as and when necessary. If illness occurs during their course they will be cared in the Hospital. If immunized is required, Sree Balaji Medical College & Hospital is utilized.

HOSTEL

- Hostel facilities are provided to those who need. Rooms are provided with furniture. Each student must bring bedding/ mattress, pillows, sheets, pillow covers and bed spreads.
- They should not bring any valuable jewellery the college will not take any responsibility for loss or theft.
- Food will be provided in the hostel. The mess charges must be paid the 10th of every month.

ANTI RAGGING COMMITTEE
