INTRODUCTION

Leprosy or Hansen's disease chronic, mildly infectious malady capable of producing, when untreated, various deformities and disfigurements. It is caused by the rod-shaped bacterium *mycobacterium leprae*, first described by G. Armauer Hansen, a Norwegian physician, 1874. The mode of transmission is not fully understood. It is thought to be transmitted by nasal discharges and skin sores, and possibly also by contaminated objects and anthropoids and by infected armadillos (which are also susceptible to the disease). Only 5% of those exposed acquires the disease. The onset is intermittent a gradual; symptoms may not appear until years after exposure. It is seldom fatal, but its involvement of the peripheral nerves destroys sensation and makes the patient prone to advertent injury.

The lectures has been shows the difference between the leprosy condition and certain skin infections. At the end of the training session all the students of 4th year BSC Nursing had stood up for the pledge and had wind up the programme by clearing all doubts related to the campaign.

NATIONAL DEWORMING DAY

The National Deworming Day is an initiative of Ministry of Health and Family Welfare, Government of India to make every child in the country worm free. This is one of the largest public health programs reaching large number of children during a short period.

The National Deworming Day is conducted in all states/UTs on February 10 every year, with a mop-up day on February 15. According to World Health Organization 241 million children between the ages of 1 and 14 years are at risk of parasitic intestinal worms in India, also known as Soil-Transmitted Helminths (STH). Helminths (worms) which are transmitted through soil contaminated with faecal matter are called soil-transmitted Helminths (Intestinal parasitic worms). Roundworm (*Ascaris lumbricoides*), whipworm (*Trichuris trichiura*) and hookworms (*Necator americanus* and *Ancylostoma duodenale*) are worms that infect people

SOIL TRANSMITTED HELMINTHS TRANSMISSION:

- ✚ Adult worms live in human intestines for food and survival and produce thousands of eggs each day.
- ✚ Eggs are passed in the faeces of infected person.
- ✚ Eggs contaminate the soil and spread infection in several ways: —
- ✚ Ingested through vegetables that are not carefully cooked, washed or peeled;
- ✚ ingested from contaminated water sources;
- ✚ ingested by children who play in soil and then put their hands in their mouths without washing them.

The programme is being implemented through the combined efforts of Department of School Education and Literacy under Ministry of Human Resource and Development, Ministry of Women and Child Development and Ministry of Drinking Water and Sanitation

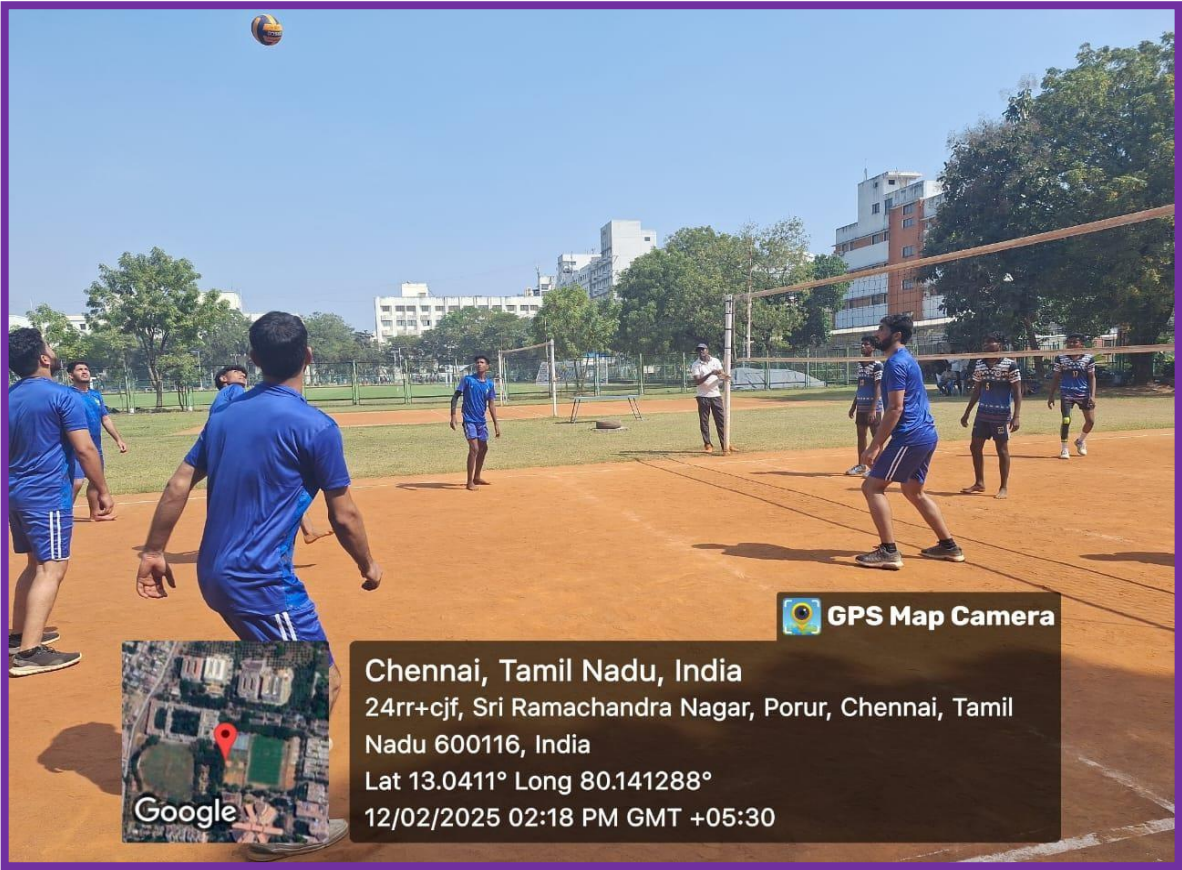

Sir discussed the basic principles of triage in emergency settings and explained triage categories and patient prioritization techniques.

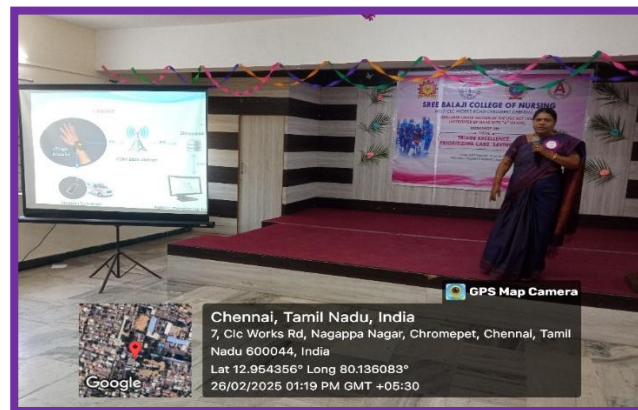
The session concluded with honoring the resource person with a certificate and memento by the principal of Sree Balaji College of Nursing.

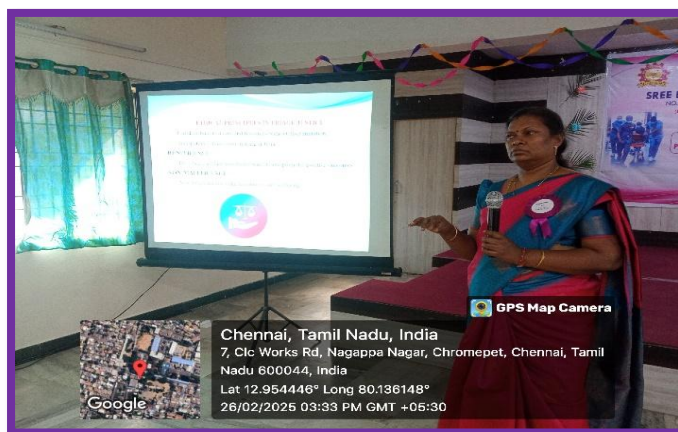
Mam has highlighted the importance of disaster management and preparedness in triage and discussed protocols for mass casualty incidents.

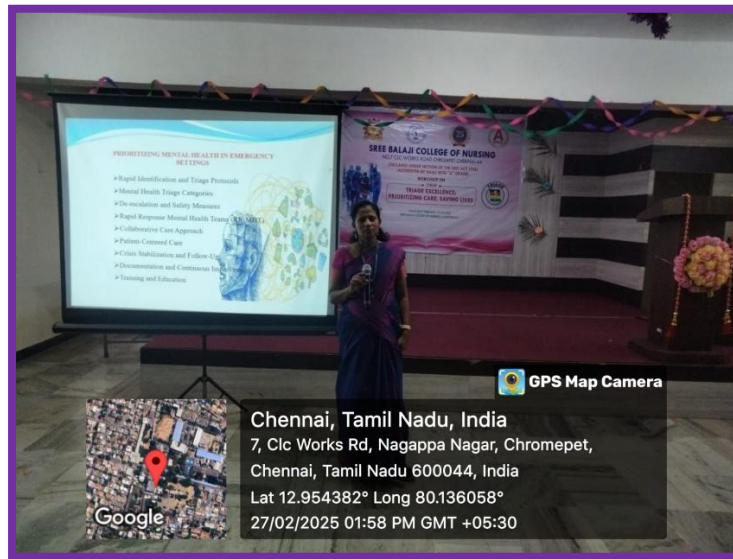

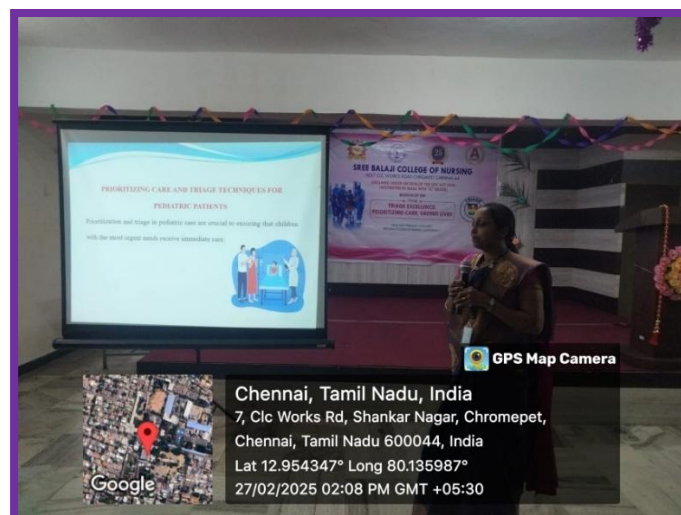
