

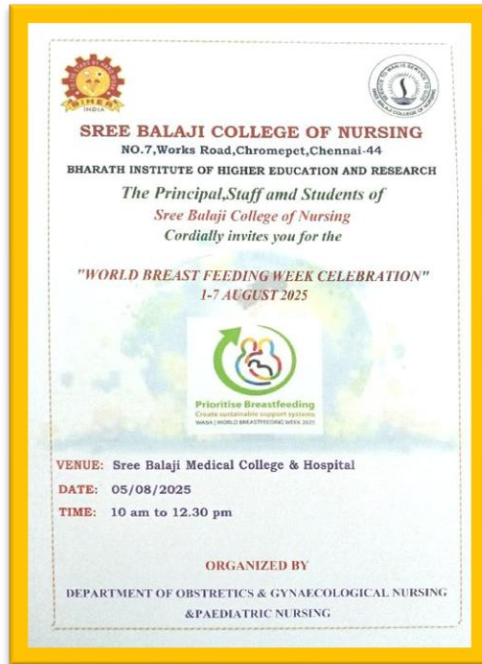

INTRODUCTION:

The final year B.Sc. Nursing students of Sree Balaji College of Nursing conducted a School Health Program at Government School, Serpancherai, Padappai on **07. 08.2025**. The program focused on assessing the health status of school children, creating awareness about personal hygiene, nutrition, and common health problems. Health education sessions were carried out with active participation of students and teachers. The program aimed at promoting the overall well-being of children and strengthening preventive health practices within the school community.

OBJECTIVES:

- ★ To assess and monitor the health status of children in the community schools.
- ★ To detect and prevent common health problems such as malnutrition, anemia, infections, and dental issues.
- ★ To promote awareness on personal hygiene, sanitation, and healthy habits among children, parents, and teachers.
- ★ To ensure a healthy school environment with safe drinking water, clean toilets, and proper waste disposal.
- ★ To identify children with special needs or disabilities and provide referral services to higher health facilities.

- ★ To strengthen nutrition through mid-day meals and nutrition education.
- ★ To encourage community participation by involving parents, teachers, and local leaders in child health promotion.
- ★ To reduce absenteeism and improve learning by maintaining good health among school children.

The National Deworming Day is an initiative of Ministry of Health and Family Welfare, Government of India to make every child in the country worm free. This is one of the largest public health programs reaching large number of children during a short period. This Program is being implemented by the state **since 2015**.

Helminths (worms) which are transmitted through soil contaminated with fecal matter are called soil-transmitted helminths (Intestinal parasitic worms). Soil transmitted helminths infection can lead to anemia, malnutrition, impaired physical, mental & cognitive development, and reduced school participation.

Sree balaji college of Nursing under the guidance of Pallavaram PHC distributed Albendazole tablet to I year BSc nursing student on **13.8.2025** . Principal Mrs. V.Hemavathy distributed the tablets along with I year Bsc nursing coordinator and community helth department staff.

The objective of National Deworming Day is deworming all the children (school enrolled and non-enrolled) **aged 1 to 19 years**, through the platform of schools and Anganwadi Centers in order to improve their overall health, nutritional status, access to education and quality of life.

All children (both boys and girls) in the age group of 1-19 years

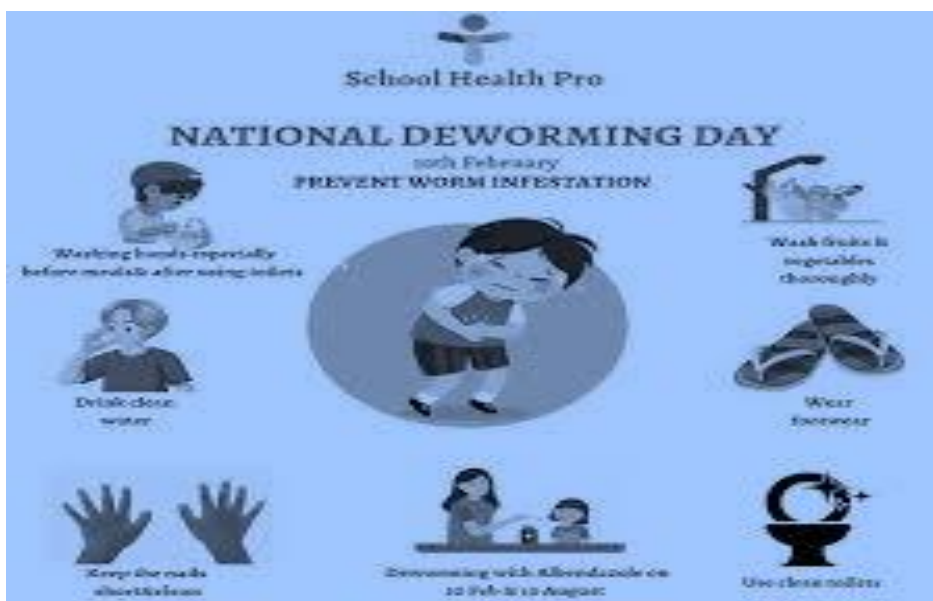
IMPLEMENTATION

Bi-annual Deworming – February and August of every year

DOSAGE SCHEDULE

Important: Children who are sick or are on medication on deworming day/mop up day (MUD) should not be given the drug. These

children should be advised to take Albendazole tablet upon recovery or after consultation with the medical doctor.



KAVAL UTHAVI

Kaaval Uthavi app is used to trigger & send 'Emergency' alert to control room in order to get immediate assistance by general public during any kind of distress/emergency. It also provides many services like Police station locator with direction & dial feature, control room directory & its dial services, other help line directory & its dial service, notification / alert services are integrated to ensure and avail various kind of emergency assistance & other services. TNP e-services such as Police verification, lost document report, Vehicle verification, FIR & CSR status etc. are also integrated.



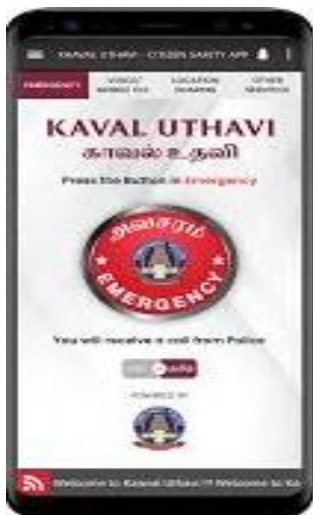
WHO IS THE KAVALAN SOS APP FOR?



Citizens of Tamil Nadu especially women and children, can use the Kavalan App whenever they feel vulnerable or threatened so that help from the Police can reach them at the earliest no matter where they are. People can also contact the Police instantly through this service during emergencies such as natural disasters. Anonymous complaints can also be verified immediately, saving time and resources in the price

HOW DOES THE “KAVALAN SOS” APP WORK ?

- ★ Tamil Nadu Police Department’s official app "Kavalan SOS" is available for Android and iOS.



- ★ After installation, provide your personal mobile number, home address and an alternate mobile number for registration.
 - ★ Post registration, provide mandatory details like your email address, date of birth, gender, address and city.
 - ★ Provide contact details of any TWO relatives or close friends as Emergency Contacts preferably living in the same city. Details such as mobile number, name and relationship is mandatory. Additionally, you can add a third contact person as an Emergency contact.
- ★ You will receive an activation code on your registered mobile number to complete sign up.

- ★ Enter your activation code and your sign in process is complete. The Kavalan Home screen will be displayed post this.
- ★ During an emergency, pressing the SOS button on the home page starts a 5 second countdown.
- ★ After 5 seconds, the app automatically sends your current location on the map along with a video from your back camera to the Kavalan team. Within a minute, the team will contact you. Simultaneously, your location will also be sent to your preregistered "Emergency Contacts" as an SMS alert.

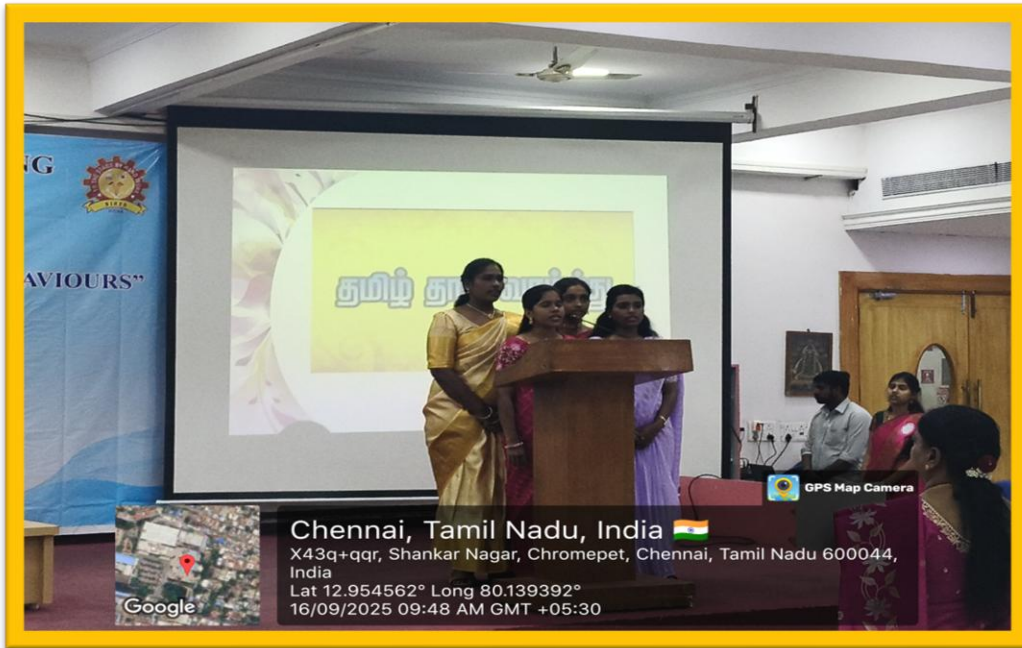
